Deep Run Quarterly Business Meeting...held on January 10, 2010

The first quarterly business meeting of the New Year was held on Sunday, January 10, 2010 at 5 pm. The meeting was called to order by Pastor Dave and Tim Hardy gave the opening prayer. We then sang a congregational hymn, *To God be the Glory*. Pastor Dave read the minutes from the previous business meeting. There were no corrections or additions and they were approved. Randy Smith, church treasurer, gave the treasurer's report of funds available totaling \$48,747.05.

Old Business—

Ditch and tile situation—still no further action taken.

Walk of Fame bricks—Curtis Harper was not present and thus unable to give an update.

Harper House traffic—Gerald Smith put up posts across the field where the traffic was coming from (thank-you)—now it appears some are coming across from another way.

Playground—the playground is complete. Equipment is set up and mulch is put down. A *Grandparents Swing* was donated by Pastor Dave and Stacy...adults can now sit and swing while watching their children play.

Harper House—a vote was taken to determine what the church was going to do with it. The vote was 71 in favor of getting rid of it and 15 in favor of keeping it. Gerald Smith asked for the garage and has moved it off the property already. Dempsey and Shelba Hill have asked for the Harper House and are making plans to have it moved in the near future.

New Business—

Membership—we have had three new members to join our church family, Joshua Fishman, Sarah Fishman, and Becky Hardison. Welcome!

Budget Proposal for 2010—Randy Smith gave us the new budget proposal. He stated we have paid \$32,000 on our loan for the new bathrooms and we have less than \$10,000 left to go. He also stated that the budget stayed nearly the same as last year except for utilities, they increased. The budget was passed out for all to see and afterwards was approved unanimously.
