First Baptist Church of Deep Run—Quarterly Business Meeting Minutes October 9, 2011

The quarterly business meeting of the First Baptist Church of Deep Run was held on Sunday evening, October 9, 2011 at 5:30 p.m. Pastor Dave Fishman called the meeting to order and Tim Hardy led in prayer. We sang the congregational hymn, *What a Friend We Have in Jesus*. Valeria Taylor read the minutes from the July meeting. There were no corrections or additions and the minutes were approved as read. Valeria also gave the treasurer's report of an on-hand balance of \$93,174.19. \$4,200 of this total is in designated funds.

Old Business

- The Hazel Smith family is still open to suggestions as to how to spend the money in the memorial fund. Any suggestions need to be made to Pastor Dave or Tim Hardy.
- Cemetery information is not available at this time. Pastor Dave will look into this matter.

New Business

- Tim Hardy presented a recommendation from the Deacons that the church approve an additional \$1,500.00 in travel allowance for Pastor Dave for this calendar year. Iris Aldridge made the motion to approve this and Tom Parham seconded the motion. It was approved unanimously.
- Kevin Wiggins presented a report from the Building Committee concerning the repairs being made after the recent hurricane. The church received \$8,300.00 in insurance money. Repairs include work on the roof, replacing some siding, caulking windows, replacing the two doors in the back rooms of the church, waterproofing the sanctuary walls, and some painting. Johnny Stroud is going to give a price for the painting.
- Kevin also reported that he still only has one quote on paving the north side parking lot. Curtis Harper is going to contact someone to get another quote.
- Carpet in the Fellowship Hall needs to be cleaned. Johnny Stroud has been asked to take care of getting this done in the next few weeks.
- Stacy Fishman said that the rug on the front porch needs to be replaced and Kevin is going to take care of this.
- Valeria Taylor said that the door in the vestibule on the north side of church sticks and is often difficult to open. Kevin is going to look into this.
- Tom Parham asked about ordering more memorial bricks and it was decided that we would do this again at the beginning of the year so that new bricks could be here in time for our Homecoming Sunday.
- The question was asked about the land behind the church that is now for sale. Kevin reported that the asking price is \$80,000 and there is no access to Highway 11. Several people suggested that we just wait on this issue.

Announcements

- New member since last meeting: Linda Smith Pollock moved membership 6 Aug. 21
- Matthew Hill has resigned as the paid Youth Minister. He will still volunteer time as available.
- The Associational Sing Service held on Aug. 13 was very successful.

As there was no further business, we had a prayer and adjourned.
